He has been studying journalism at St. Michael's College in Vermont where he plans to complete his degree once he has successfully completed his treatment. As Colin's mom, Sharon McTygue, wrote, "the road less travelled will lead Colin right back onto Route 7 headed north to Saint Mike's yet again, to pick up right where he left off, in a place where he has the whole world (and life) in front of him!"

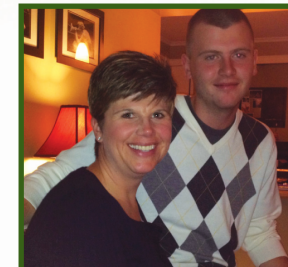
In May 2013, he began his unexpected journey when he was diagnosed with Mediastinal Large B-cell Lymphoma, a very aggressive form of cancer. Colin has a large tumor on his left lung and around his pulmonary artery. There is a new treatment protocol for this type of Lymphoma that has proven to be very successful. It is a necessary and aggressive treatment to combat this type of cancer. He must stay at Albany Medical Center for 6 days as an inpatient every 21 days, up 6 to 8 times. It sounds daunting, but whatever it takes, Colin is willing to do. Colin's words, "I'm okay, it's okay, and it will be okay" reflect the positive attitude that he is maintaining throughout this process.

What you need to know:

- Please be on your golf cart ready to go at 12:30
- Rangers will escort you to your starting tee at 12:45
- 1pm start, begin when you reach your tee

Cart Rules:

Practice the 90 degree rule, this means that you stay on the path until you reach the area of your ball, drive out onto the fairway, take your shot & return directly to the path, please **KEEP YOUR VEHICLE ON THE PATH NEAR ALL TEES & GREENS**

Stay left on #11/#18 London Bridge, the women's tee for #11/ drop area will have carts stopped on bridge.

Competitions:

- (1) Longest Drive - #8 men under 65 from WHITES, men over 65 GOLDS, women from REDS
- (2) Most Accurate Dr. #5 – separate men & women
- (3) Closest to Pin #9 & #17 - combined
- (4) Closest to Pin 2nd Shot #12 & #14 – combined
- (5) HOLE IN ONE #9 Saratoga Skydiving Adventures Tandem Skydive
- (6) Skins (optional) by team \$20

Rules:

Women play from reds, men play from whites EXCEPT #18 from GOLDS (play as a par 4 for everyone), senior men 65 & over may play from GOLDS

Format:

- 4-Player Scramble
- Team will consist of 4 players.
- All 4 hit drive off the tee.
- Team decides which ball has the better lie, everyone hits from that spot, continue this process until the ball is holed out.
- If you have only 3 players on your team, you may take turns, rotating by hole, taking a second shot. (The person taking the second shot does so for the entire hole and then switch the person for the next hole)

MUST USE EACH PLAYERS DRIVE once on front 9 & once on back 9. MARK YOUR SCORECARD WITH A "*" next to each players name on scorecard when drive used. Thank you.

You may move ball one club length on fairway (no closer to hole). You may not improve your lie from rough, sand bunker or water hazard. You may move ball 3 inches on green (no closer to the hole).
